2015 Mercy Woman of the Year

Jean Brennan

Each year Swing for Mercy recognizes a woman who exemplifies the Mercy spirit of compassion and service through her own commitment to the mission of the Sisters of Mercy. We take great pride in honoring Jean Brennan as the 2015 Mercy Woman of the Year.

A lifelong resident of Wilkes-Barre, Jean graduated from St. Nicholas High School in 1956 along with her future husband Joe Brennan. Jean started work at the Second National Bank, and Joe began his career in the newspaper business. Following their marriage and beginning a family, the couple built their home in Shavertown in 1964, and family became Jean's career, as she volunteered for various school, Scouts, and community affairs projects.

Jean's involvement in Ministry began when she and her husband Joe became team leaders within the Marriage Encounter Community. The couple later served as Back Mountain Area Coordinators for Religious Education, and were one of the first husband and wife Eucharistic Ministers in their parish of St. Therese's. In 1990 Jean began a 16-year career as Pastoral Associate/Director of Family Life for her parish.

Following Joes' death in 1993, a memorial Golf Tournament was held in his honor and continued for 10 years under Jean's leadership. Jean continues her service as a volunteer on the Bereavement, Liturgy, and Social Justice Committees.

Jean's relationship with the Sisters of Mercy began when she became a Mercy Associate in 1991. Over the years she has developed an appreciation for all that the Mercy Presence has brought not only to our region, but to the worldwide community through their work in social justice.

Jean is fortunate to have her three children and their families reside locally. For the last 18 years she has been active in her role as Grandma for her four grandchildren, and for the last 10 years she has been caregiver for her mother, who at age 98 resides at Mercy Center in Dallas.
